Fishing Report

Since the last newsletter, there have been three inshore competitions and an artificial bait competition held.

The first inshore comp was held on the 25th-26th of March and was won by Scott Nolan with a bag of whiting (2 bonus), 1 bream and 1 sweetlip for 147 points. Second place went to Sharon Toonen who had the species of the trip, sweetlip, weighing 1.21 kg's and 93 points.

The second inshore comp was held on the 8th-9th of April and was again won by Scott Nolan on 211 points. Scott's catch included a bag of whiting (one bonus which was also the species of the trip), 2 javelin, 1 parrot, 1 tarwhine and a bream. Second place went to Ernie Richards with 170 points.

The third inshore comp was held on the 29th-30th of April and was won by Mark Mills with 200 points. Mark's haul included 2 bonus snapper, 7 whiting and 2 flathead. Second place again went to Ernie Richards on 195 points. Paul Crisafulli had the species of the trip, bream, weighing in at 975 grams.

Winner of the artificial bait day held on the 7th of May was Dave Russell with 3 flathead. Jeff Cooke came in second.
